





Tabata Shoothouse is a world-class training facility that provides an advanced close-quarters combat laboratory, office space, operations center and meeting rooms. Tabata Shoothouse enables Raven and Gryphon Group to conduct complex multi-dimensional scenarios in a very realistic environment.

Raven and Gryphon's Shoothouse can be populated with language enabled role players dressed and acting as citizens in any particular region of the world while televisions can display recent news events or television shows from any country in the world. Radios can play music from the target country and target language signs, books, and magazines may be displayed which will create very realistic training environments to practice specific mission scenarios.










Gibson Training Facility

Gibson Training Facility is approximately 180 acres with two certified drop zones, a 200-meter range, 50-meter range, 360-degree range, 650-meter range (to get extended out to 1200-1400 meters), a 100-meter range, off road trails, lodging/classroom areas, 10 acres + lake, and a covered shoot house coming soon. Located 17 miles from the Gryphon Group Training Facility.

<u>Technical Close Target Reconnaissance</u> – We provide instruction on using technology to provide standoff of personnel from a target area to greatly reduce physical signature and lower the risk of compromise during a surveillance operation. Video intelligence collection is conducted through manned or standalone devices using wireless data export to a remote viewing/control station.

<u>Tagging, Tracking, and Locating_(TTL)</u> – Training is conducted on the use of Government Off the Shelf (GOTS) equipment (Customer owned) and Commercial Off the Shelf (COTS) equipment. Training on operational planning, employment considerations, and concealment fabrication techniques for vehicles and other requirements. TTL can be used for surveillance operations or for tracking the movement of items.





Locations 1 and 2 span distances up to 3km, with locations 3 and 4 having a 2km plus range around it. Location 3 and 4 can also be used for simulation round and live fire exercises with counter UAS equipment worked into the live fire or simulation fire scenario.


The max effective range of most handheld counter UAS jammers are 750 meters to 1000 meters, with the human operator typically only seeing a group 1 UAS quad or multi rotary winged UAS at about 250 meters and a group 2 fixed wing UAS at about 350 meters. For training purposes, Gryphon group has more than the distances needed to implement tactical counter UAS training and electronic counter measures training.
